

## Pillow Case Dress

### Supplies:

One Pillowcase or

Fabric to make a pillowcase in the following amounts

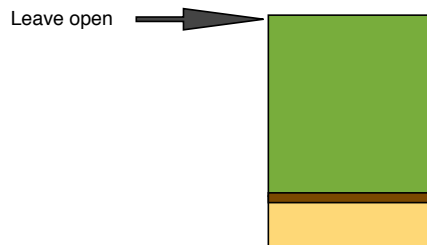
¾ yd (27") main fabric for body of pillowcase

¼ yd (9") cuff fabric

3" for accent or other types of trim (44" long)

3 strips 6" by WOF for 2 ties or 2 strips 6" by WOF for single tie.

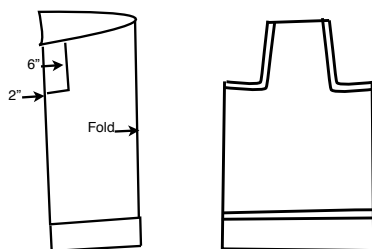
Assemble pillowcase – Follow pillowcase instructions to complete pillowcase but do not close bottom of pillowcase.



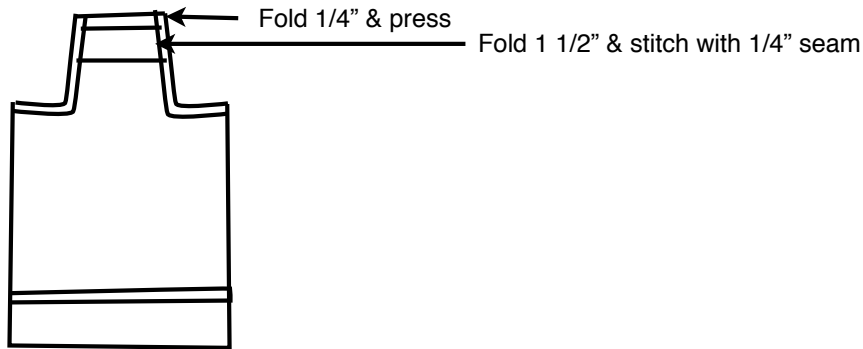
Determine dress size – cut excess length from top. Size Chart:

<u>Size</u>	<u>Armhole</u>	<u>Width</u>	<u>Cut length</u>	<u>Finished Length</u>
4-5	6"	22	25 ½ "	24
6-8	6"	22	27 ½ "	26

**Armholes:** With cuff of pillowcase on the bottom, fold pillowcase in half lengthwise. Measure in 2" from side and mark; measure down from open end 6". Cut out J shape. Armholes will be kept uniform in shape by cutting both arm holes at the same time. Trim with bias binding or press ¼ " around armhole then press again ¼ " and stitch in place.



**Casing for Ties:** Press top front down  $\frac{1}{4}$  "; Press down again  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ". Top stitch using a  $\frac{1}{4}$  " seam; Top stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$  " at top of casing. Repeat with top back.



**Ties:** Join tie strips together at short end. Fold strip in half lengthwise and sew. Press. If two ties are to be used, cut strip in half and thread one piece through each casing; if single tie, thread strip through back, then through front casing. Finish end of ties by cutting at an angle, press raw edges inside  $\frac{1}{4}$  " and top stitch.
