## Wallets Revised 4/19

Cut 1 of each, if you have directional fabric; make sure you have cut the fabric the direction you wanted.

- A. 3" x 8" Front Pocket Print
- B. 4" x 8" Back inside Solid
- C.  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8" Money pocket print
- D.  $5\frac{1}{2}$  × 8" Back denim or print

A and B Turn down to wrong side the top edge  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press and turn down  $\frac{1}{4}$ " again, press and stitch. You can also serge the edge and then turn down  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and press and stitch

Place A on top of B right sides up and fold in the center vertically and stitch on this line making sure the top of the stitch line is secured as this area will receive a lot of wear as the lunch/library/ID card may be moved in and out frequently.

Line up the bottoms of A, B and C all right side up and place D right side down on top. Flip over and sewing on the A, B, C side, sew 3/8" on the right and left sides and bottom, making sure you have caught all the pieces. Turn out to make sure everything is ok and make sure you have the pockets correct on the inside, don't panic if it doesn't look right, you probably have inverted it incorrectly. Turn inside out and trim seam to 1/8", angling the corners. Return to right side out.

Fold in at angle the sides of D flap at the top and give it a short seam to hold it. Either serge the top seam or fold/press a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and fold down again  $\frac{1}{4}$ " and top stitch.
