## 10 Minute Period Pack Go With The Flow

Cut fabric, sew short ends, fold and sew long sides, turn right side out.

Ta dah!!

Materials - 1 or 2 pieces fabric, cut to 18" x 8 1/2" (see notes) thread

Step 1 - Cut fabric to desired size.



## See notes about embellishing now!!

Step 2 - (single fabric) Fold & press 1/2" on short ends. Fold that under & press. Stitch hem, using a fun decorative stitch.

(*double fabric*) Place fabric right sides together. Straight stitch across short ends. Press, turn right side out, press again.

Step 3 - Folding toward the **right side**, fold 3" down, fold 5" up from other end. The overlap should be about 1" - 2". Any design should be in the middle section. Sew side seams using an overlock or zigzag or straight stitch.

Step 4 - Turn right side out, and press. Ta dah!!

## Notes-

- 1. If you want a heavier pack, use 2 pieces of fabric. One piece obviously uses less fabric.
- 2. I cut mine 18" x 8 1/2" because that's the size of my ruler. Other sizes acceptable.
- 3. If you want to embroidery directly on the pack, do that before you do any sewing and the fabric is still flat. Attached embellishments are easier to add flat too.
- 4. I usually consider the middle 1/2 of the fabric as the front side, and do the embellishing in that area.
- 5. I don't usually measure the folds, but just make sure there is a reasonable sized overlap.
- 6. I prefer using the sewing machine overcast or overlock stitch instead of a serger because I don't have to fiddle with the serger tails. That probably saves 5 minutes.
